

## Éléonore Mine, Québec, Canada

**Year of Completion:** 2010

Éléonore is a new mine situated close to James Bay with a total of 9.4m ounces of measured and inferred gold reserves, reaching a depth of 1500m.

DavyMarkham undertook a full scope project including the design, manufacture, fabrication and trial assembly of a 12ft (3.6m) double drum production hoist, with geared twin motor drive and two 8ft (2.4m) single drum auxiliary hoists, with geared single motor drives, for Opinaca's Éléonore Mine.

Following the successful delivery of the hoists and all mechanical and electrical components to Québec, Opinaca Mines have since ordered two subsequent mine hoists from DavyMarkham. The new order includes a 20.5ft production hoist, to be delivered to Éléonore Mine in 2012 and an 18ft diameter service hoist for 2014.
